The UBC Faculty of Forestry's Forest Carbon Management (FCM) Micro-Certificate is a flexible 8-week online program that provides natural resource managers with an understanding of forest carbon accounting, related data sources and analysis, and the architecture of forest carbon projects and associated markets. The program is comprised of four courses, each taking two weeks of study time, about 60 hours of instruction.
